Join Kevin as he leads you to some of the best wines produced in Napa Valley. You will visit his favorite vintners and taste the amazing wine that reigns supreme in Napa.

Day 1 - Meet at Sacramento airport for your private transfer to Napa to enjoy a leisurely "winemaker's lunch" then visit a second winery for sampling before checking into The River Terrace Inn (L)

One barrel of wine makes about 20 cases, or 1200 glasses. A ton of grapes equals 720 bottles of wine, or 60 cases. One vine annually produces between four and six bottles of wine, or 20 and 30 glasses. Each bottle of wine contains about 2.8 pounds of grapes; each 5-ounce glass of wine a little over half a pound.

The vineyards around Yountville are protected from the wind and fog of San Pablo Bay

Oakville, Rutherford and St Helena consistently produce world class Cabernet Sauvignon

Stags Leap is separated from Napa Valley by hills that funnel cool winds to the region

The hills of Atlas Peak once grew Sangiovese, but many producers replaced them with Cab vines

Mount Veeder is prized for its scarce and high-quality grape production of Cab, Zin and Syrah

Spring Mountain & Diamond Mountain are known for their cult Cabs made in very low quantities

Grapes grown on Howell Mountain are famous for their concentrated flavors and aromas

Chiles Valley is one of the state's premium Zinfandel producing region
